Good morning Eric,

We are currently on the subject well with the drilling rig. We have made slow progress over the weekend getting to a depth of $\sim 2,310'$ (below the Fox Hills top). We have been getting a mix of cement and possible formation, with low weight on bit. We plan to go for another hour or two this morning but are afraid of sidetracking this high up in the wellbore (due to shallow surface casing and drilling on this hard zone for as long as we have). If the conditions don't improve soon, I propose plugging from depth back to surface.

Please let me know if you have any questions in your review for the approval to deviate from the original plugging plan.
