Dear Ms. Martin,

Fulcrum Energy Operating, LLC ("Fulcrum") is the operator of the Coalmont 3-13H oil and gas well located on the captioned lands. Fulcrum has decided to plug and abandon the Coalmont 3-13H well and therefore, Fulcrum no longer has any reason to continue utilizing the flowlines connecting Coalmont 3-13H Well with the storage tanks located on the Coalmont 3-13H Production Facility ("Flowlines"). Pursuant to the rules of the Colorado Energy and Carbon Management Commission ("ECMC"), Fulcrum is required to provide Jackson County notice of its intent to abandon the Flowlines.

Fulcrum is obligated to either (i) abandon the Flowlines "in-place" or (ii) remove the Flowlines. Both affected surface owners have verbally agreed to allow abandonment of the Flowlines in-place. If for some reason we are unable to obtain written approval to abandon the Flowlines in-place, Fulcrum will remove the Flowlines, commencing May 21st, 2026.

This letter seeks to obtain your written permission to waive the 15-day pre-abandonment notice, per ECMC Rule 1105.d(4), in order to begin timely abandonment per ECMC requirements. If you are agreeable to waive the 15-day pre-abandonment notice, per ECMC Rule 1105.d(4), please sign the Waiver attached hereto as Page 2 and return to the undersigned via email.
