This well is on land on which I own the surface rights.

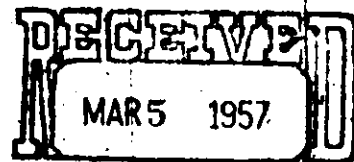

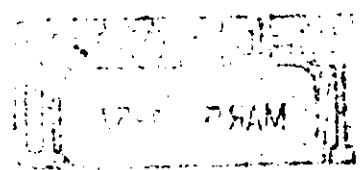
The following information was obtained from the Denver office:
