Comment Vegetation at the location is well established and is primarily composed of smooth brome, western wheatgrass, Sandberg bluegrass and other perennial grasses. Secondary species include bulbous bluegrass, cheatgrass, redstem fillaree and weedy annual mustard species. Tertiary species include alfalfa, clasping pepperweed, big sagebrush and yellow salsify. Prickly Russian thistle and kochia are present on the edges of the working pad surface. Multiple noxious weed species are present in the interim areas; see Good Housekeeping section for weed control CA. Overall, interim areas are progressing towards 1003 reclamation requirements.
